PLACE AND DATE

Hotel ISTRAN – Rovinj, Croatia.
May 4-7, 2017.

Rovinj is a charming little town on the western coast of Istria in Croatia, the largest peninsula on the Adriatic coastline, a one hour drive from Trieste, 2.5 hours from Zagreb and 6 hours from Munich. It has rich natural and cultural heritage with beautiful landmarks such as the old town, the Golden Cape Park Forest, islands and coastal area. The protected historical old town center that dates from the period between the 3rd and 5th century a.d. is the most miraculous and interesting part of Rovinj.

Sveti Andrija (Croatian for Saint Andrew, Italian: Isola di Sant'Andrea) is a beautiful island situated near Rovinj and connected with neighbouring island of Maškin with an embankment. It was also called Crveni otok (Croatian for red island). Red Island is a fifteen-minute sail away from the town center. Taxi boats arrive from and depart for Red Island every hour. The sail to the island is very pleasant, passing by Katarina Island, Lona and Zlatni rt bays that will surely enchant you with their beauty.
